

 Fire Action When you arrive at your pitch, note the nearest Fire Point. In the event of a fire: Evacuate your accommodation and alert neighbours Move away into an open area Raise alarm by calling 999 and contacting Guest Services Do not re-enter accommodation to retrieve belongings Tackle a small fire with extinguishers, if safe to do so Fire Assembly points is at Guest Services Please keep a torch available for movement around the campsite and park at night.
No Smoking Smoking and vaping are prohibited in all accommodation and public areas.
BBQ SafetyBBQs are allowed if contained - however they must be clear of your tent and must be on solid ground.Disposable BBQ must be raised off the ground, breeze blocks have been provided for your use.Ensure any disposable BBQ and coals are cold before disposal.Please do not place BBQ between pitches and maintain a 3-metre distance from your neighbour.
Cooking Appliances Cooking is not recommended within the tent as it is a fire and a carbon monoxide risk . Please take care when using cooking stoves externally and ensure they are placed on solid surface and off the ground. Ensure the flames are extinguished after use. Do Not leave any cooking devices or BBQ unattended and keep away from combustibles.

Open Fires and fire pits are not allowed, and all cooking appliances must be contained
